Oikos is an academic publication, which comes out every six months, published by the **School of Administration and Economy** (EAE henceforth) at **Universidad Católica Silva Henríquez (UCSH)**, with headquarters in Santiago, Chile.

Its purpose is to present the main educational results of the scientific production of academic personnel and the investigators of the EAE to the scientific and academic community of Latin America.

In the accomplishment of this work, *Oikos* also aims at the development and diffusion of convergent ideas with the values of the EAE, identified with a perspective of solidarity with regards to economy and organizations.

With such intention, *Oikos* also opens its pages to works elaborated by other investigators linked to the same disciplinary field, aiming to establish with them a prolific space of encounter, dialogue and intellectual creation.

Its greater interest **is focussed on publishing unpublished works, which are the product of concluded, or developing, research studies**, that, from the diverse disciplinary perspective that make up their thematic universe, represent a real contribution to the development of the sciences of economy and administration.

These texts can take the shape of articles, research reports or critical reviews.
